There will be SA Deaf Squash Championship on the 28th April 2012 held in Durbanville, Cape Town.

After the championship there will be the Annual General Meeting held in Durbanville Squash Club on Saturday 17h00, 28 April 2012 depending on the quorum.

The players will be selected for SA Colours to take part in World Deaf Squash Championship from 1 – 6 October 2012 in England. It may occur that a few players have to go with their own budgets.

Development:

SA Deaf Squash would invite the youth squash players from each Province's Deaf Sport Federation.

SA Deaf Squash provides the equipment. Each player must have their own white/orange-yellow sole shoes. (Indoor shoes or only shoes for squash) This is very important otherwise with the wrong shoes they will not be permitted to play.

Each province carries their own pocket for the transport and the accommodation.
